- Rinko Park**
  - 5-minute walk from Minatomirai Station on the Minatomirai line
  - 15-minute walk from Sakuragicho Station on the JR line and Yokohama Municipal Subway Blue Line
- Fanzone highlights**
  - With stunning views out onto the beautiful Yokohama Bay, the Yokohama Fanzone will be the largest of all Rugby World Cup Fanzones. Come and enjoy the party atmosphere and experience the world-famous Yokohama welcome. The Fanzone will screen live broadcasts of 32 games on a large screen. Perfect for catching every piece of the action!

- There will be plenty of food, drink and entertainment on offer in the stadium that you can enjoy. Make sure you experience the unique festival atmosphere of Rugby World Cup 2019
- Don't forget your match ticket(s), only valid tickets accepted and readmission is strictly prohibited
- Fans who have purchased unofficial third party tickets face the risk of being denied stadium access
- Due to large crowds, spectators may experience delays when entering the stadium. We recommend you arrive 90 minutes early, allowing at least 60 minutes to clear security and access your seat

- As weather can fluctuate please bring appropriate clothing
  - Parking will not be available around match venues so please use public transport
  - Bring sufficient cash (Japanese Yen) in case some outlets don't accept card
  - Download the official Rugby World Cup 2019 app for the latest information
  - International Stadium Yokohama will include a specially designed Spectator Plaza with a variety of entertainment, including Heineken bars, dining outlets and Rugby World Cup 2019 activities. Arrive early and soak up the atmosphere of the area before making your way to the stadium
- The following items are prohibited from being brought into match venues
- Weapons, food and drink, cans, bottles, long umbrellas, large luggage, selfie sticks, drones, flares, radio wave emitting devices (walkie-talkies, wireless microphones, Wi-Fi routers etc)

- Please note that there will be no place to leave luggage either, inside the match venues or outside around the ticket gates
  - It is prohibited by law to fly drones in and around Rugby World Cup 2019 venues and Fanzones

**TRAVEL  
 INFORMATION**

- Check the map for your journey, listen to announcements and follow directions from staff
- There will be no parking at International Stadium Yokohama on match days. Please use public transport
- Public transport, shuttle buses and taxi services are expected to be very busy before and after the match. Make sure you factor this into your commuting time and check the times for the last train.
- The closest stations to International Stadium Yokohama are Shin-Yokohama Station (14-minute walk) and Kozukue Station (7-minute walk)
- Yokohama Fanzone is located in Rinko Park. The closest stations being Sakuragicho Station and Minatomirai Station. It takes around 60 minutes to travel from the Fanzone to the stadium so please ensure you factor this into your planning

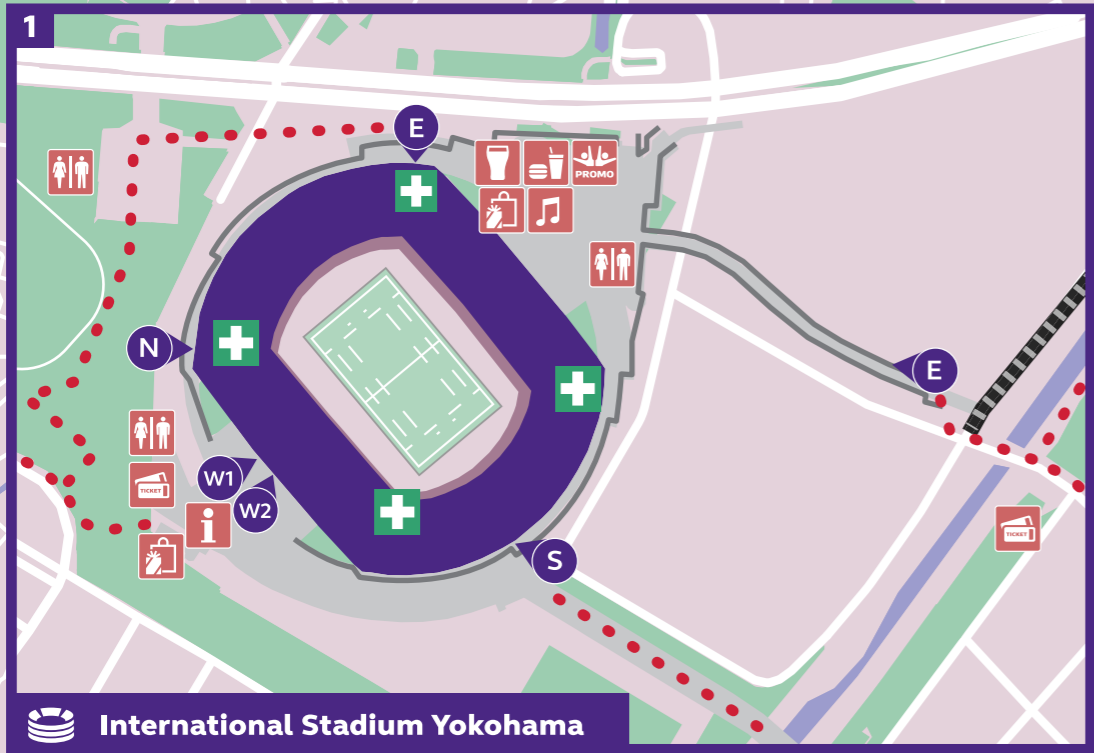
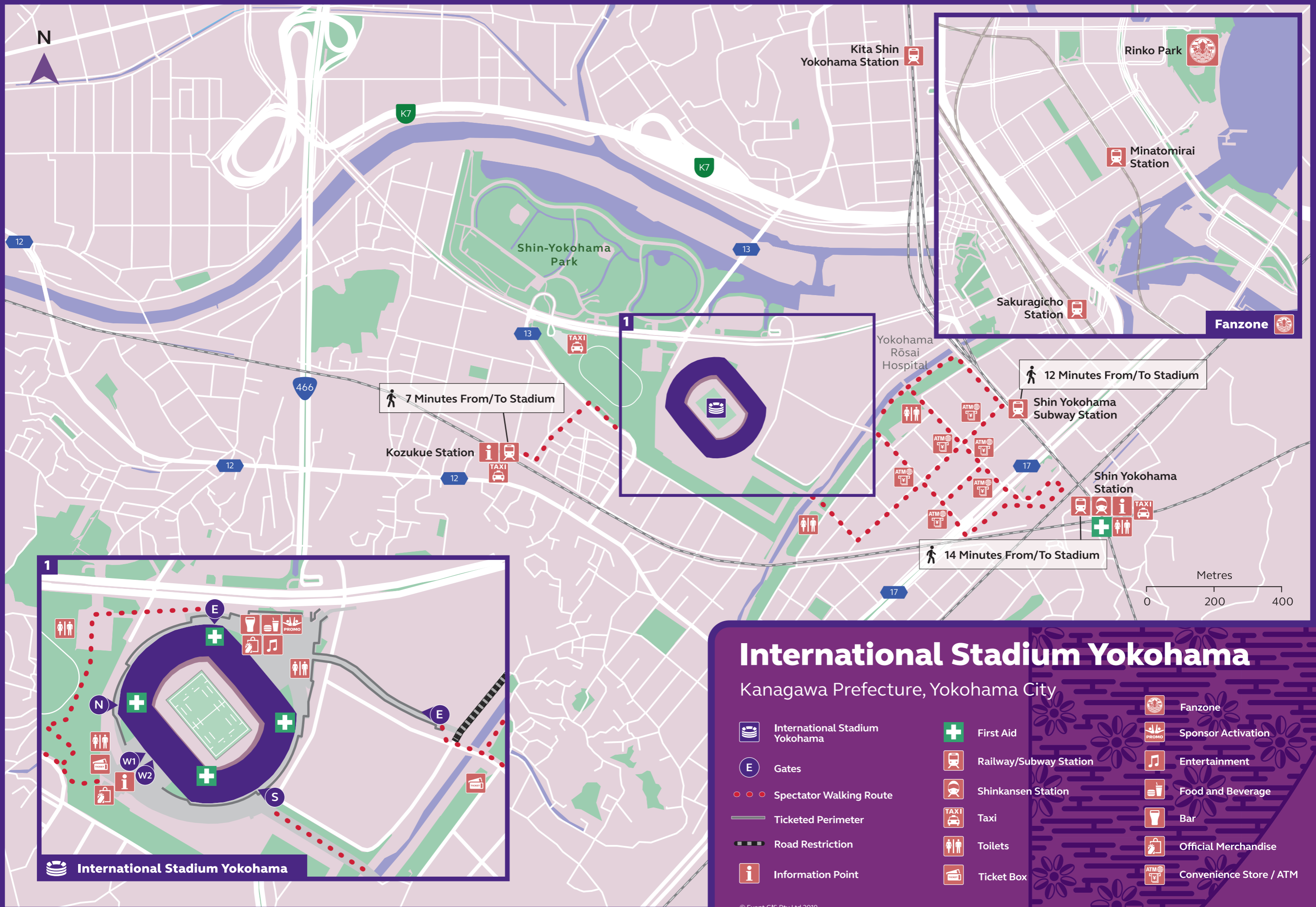
