Frequently Asked Questions

Dates & Times

The Festival is on Saturday 12th July from 10.00am to 11.00pm

The gates open at 9.30am with the first games starting at 10.00am with the first Legends game kicking off at midday. The finals will be from 6.00pm until 7.00pm and the music entertainment starts at 7.00pm until 11.00pm.

The venue closes at 11.30pm

Note; all timings are approximate and are at the discretion of the organisers

Directions (Pedestrians)

The Legends Rugby Festival is at Wimbledon RFC SW20 0ET

The nearest train station to the club is Raynes Park. From here get the 57 bus (which can be caught from outside the front of the station). You then get off at the Cottenham Park Road bus stop (about 3 stops down). Walk towards the roundabout (which is in the same direction of the bus travel and you should be able to see from the bus stop) and take a right up Cope Hill for about 300-400 meters , turn right to Barham Road and Wimbledon RFC is at the end.

Parking

We have plenty of public parking near the venue at just £5 for the day.

Please do not park in the residential roads surrounding the ground.

There is also no public parking at the rugby club.

Public and team parking - Please make your way to Colliers Wood Football Club (next to Wimbledon RFC) for parking at Wibbandune Sports Ground, Robin Hoods Way (A3), West Wimbledon. SW20 0AA.

From the South (M25) head north on the A3 past the Coombe Lane interchange, the Wibbandune sports ground is situated 800 yards past this junction on the right near a footbridge. However, you have to drive a further mile or so for the turn off marked A3 South (Portsmouth) and come back on yourself to access the ground. Stay in the inside lane and indicate early as the turn in to the ground is pretty sharp.

Corporate and VIP Parking - Corporate and VIP guests will be issues car parking passes for Wimbledon Rugby Club, Barham Rd, Wimbledon, SW20 0ET prior to the Legends Festival. Please make sure these are clearly displayed in your car on arrival, otherwise you will be refused parking.

We recommend pre ordering a taxi at the end of the night to pick up from the Barham road entrance

Tickets

You must bring a print out of your ticket or an electronic version on your phone for scanning.

Tickets are available for sale on the day of the event but we recommend pre booking to avoid disappointment.

You must wear your **wristband at all times**. If you loose your wristband you will have to buy a replacement at full face value. Parents are advised to write their mobile number on children's wristbands in case they get lost.



Food & Drink

We have fantastic food outlets and plenty of bars so you won't go hungry or thirsty. Please do not bring any food or drinks into the festival.

Legends Rugby operates the 'Challenge 21' policy. If you are lucky enough to look under 21 please do not be offended if we ask you for proof of age when you buy alcohol. Please bring proof of ID to show you are over 18.

Children

Legends Rugby festival is a family friendly event and we are delighted to have the fantastic Dazzle & Fizz entertaining your little ones all day. Plus the Tag Rugby Trust will be running a free tournament throughout the day.

Any lost children will be escorted to the event HQ where they will be looked after until a parent or guardian can be located. If you have lost a child please notify security immediately.

Useful things to bring

- Money, there are NO cash machines on the Legends Rugby Festival site so please bring cash with you as not all the food vendors will except debit cards.
- Sunscreen/hat/glasses – there isn't much shade at the festival and we are hoping for a beautiful hot day!
- Waterproof jacket – just in case

Pets

Pets are not allowed with the exception of guide dogs for the deaf or blind

Safety & Security

Your safety and well-being is the most important thing to us so a few points we would like you to follow:

- You will be asked to have your bags searched on entry. Any items that are viewed as a dangerous weapon will be confiscated and can be collected from the site after the event.
- No glass will be allowed on site
- Ensure you know where your nearest emergency exits are
- Follow any instructions given by Stewards, Security and Police



- Move away from any dangerous/antisocial behaviour and notify security
- Anyone behaving in a dangerous or antisocial manner will be removed from the site
- Stay calm – if you are injured please make your way to the first aid tent
- Please be considerate to others

Entry and Exit

We ask you to consider the local residents when you are entering and leaving the site, particularly at night. We ask you to leave quietly and not to leave the site with any drink.
