Oita Prefecture boasts the largest number of hot springs in Japan and is well known as the spa resort of Japan. There are two national parks in the prefecture, and it is a treasure trove of rich nature and food. Historical and cultural sites such as the national treasure Usa Jingu Shrine, Fuki-ji Temple, Usuki Stone Buddhas, and Hita Gion entertainment district attract many visitors both from within Japan and overseas.

- Challenge the hiking route at Kuju Kogen or Tadewara wetlands in Aso Kuju National Park

- Oita Ikoi no Michi Square
 - 5-minute walk from Oita Station south entrance
- Fanzone highlights
 - With a large screen, children's rugby corner and cultural entertainment such as traditional Kagura dancing and Taiko Japanese drum show, you'll have plenty to see and do at Oita's Ikoi no Michi Square Fanzone.
 - Find dishes unique to Oita, including fish and chips made from locally sourced yellowtail and dried shiitake mushrooms, toriten and karaage fried chicken, Hita yakisoba fried noodles and plenty more at the food and drink corner
 - Relax and unwind with special hot spring foot baths. Oita isn't called the 'Hot Spring Prefecture' for nothing!

- Don't forget your match ticket(s), only valid tickets accepted and readmission is strictly prohibited
- Fans who have purchased unofficial third party tickets face the risk of being denied stadium access

- Due to large crowds, spectators may experience delays when entering the stadium. We recommend you arrive 90 minutes early, allowing at least 60 minutes to clear security and access your seat
 - As weather can fluctuate please bring appropriate clothing
 - Parking will not be available around match venues so please use public transport
 - Bring sufficient cash (Japanese Yen) in case some outlets don't accept card
 - Download the official Rugby World Cup 2019 app for the latest information
- The following items are prohibited from being brought into match venues
- Weapons, food and drink, cans, bottles, long umbrellas, large luggage, selfie sticks, drones, flares, radio wave emitting devices (walkie-talkies, wireless microphones, WI-Fi routers etc)

- Please note that there will be no place to leave luggage either, inside the match venues or outside around the ticket gates
 - It is prohibited by law to fly drones in and around Rugby World Cup 2019 venues and Fanzones

- Check the map for your journey, listen to announcements and follow directions from staff
- The park and ride and shuttle bus services to the stadium are free of charge. Shuttle bus services will begin four hours before kick-off and end two hours after each match
- Public transportation is expected to be extremely busy during the tournament. We urge spectators to enter Oita as early as possible before the match and make your way to Oita or Beppu Stations as soon as possible after the match if you intend on travelling on from there.
- Allow plenty of time to get your transport and do not leave it until the last service
