FRANCE v SCOTLAND at Stade de France, 7.2.2015 (18:00 local time)

Head coach Philippe Saint-Andre hands RBS 6 Nations debuts to a third of his starting lineup, with prop **Alexandre Menini**, half-backs **Rory Kockott** & **Camille Lopez**, wing **Teddy Thomas** and full-back **Scott Spedding** all making first starts in rugby's greatest championship. Included on the bench is uncapped 25-year-old La Rochelle back-rower **Loann Goujon**.

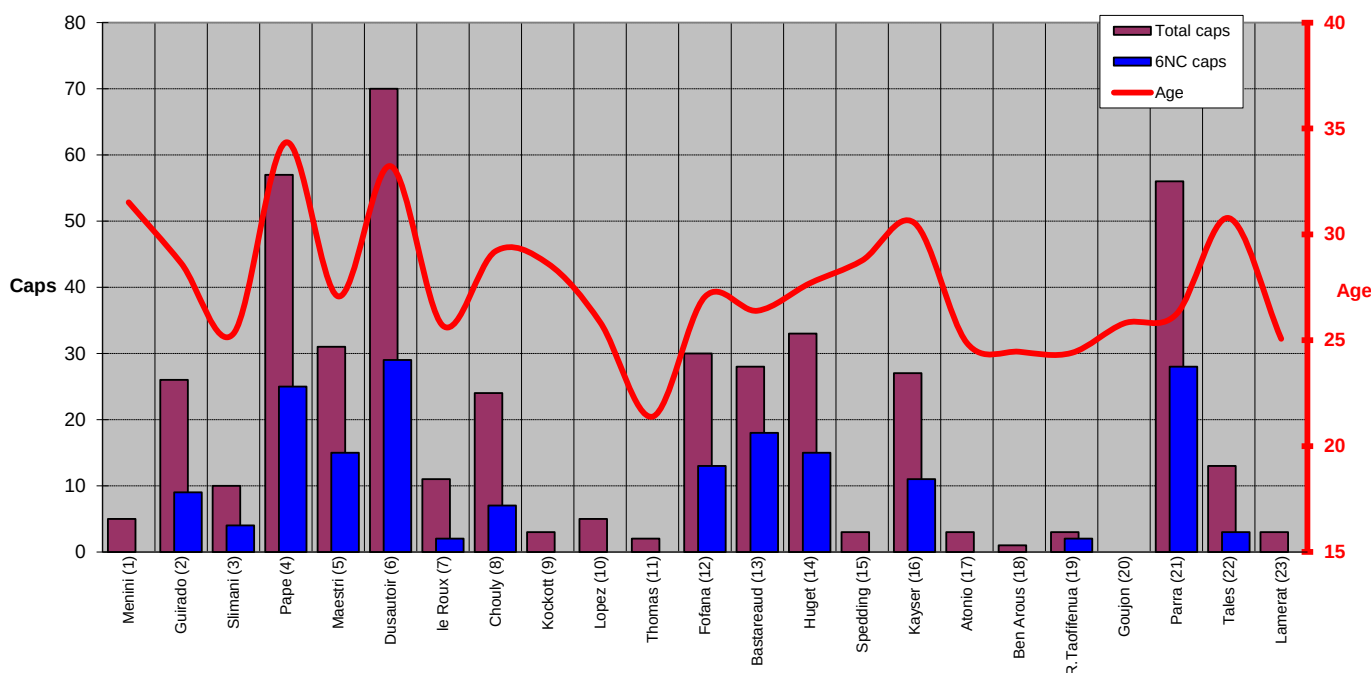
Seven different clubs are represented in the walk-on team.

The XV has 444 test caps between them; the bench has a further 181 caps.

The half-back combination of **Rory Kockott** and **Camille Lopez** account for just 1.2% of the starting caps.

The average age of the walk-on team is 28 years; the average on the bench is 26.5
