GETTING TO THE FANZONE

Sapporo will host two Fanzones

- Sapporo Odori Park
 - 2-minute walk from Odori Subway Station
 - Opening days: 20-29 September (10 days)*
- Sapporo Station South Plaza
 - 1-minute walk from JR Sapporo Station
 - Opening days: 20-22 September (3 days)*
- Fanzone highlights

Located in the same park as Sapporo's world-famous annual snow festival and also at the station known as the 'gateway to Sapporo', Sapporo's Fanzones will host many special events throughout the tournament for spectators to enjoy. Gather in the heart of this magnificent city to experience a once-in-a-lifetime Rugby World Cup 2019 - Sapporo style!

*Please note due to the expected crowds on 20-22 September admission to the Fanzone may be limited

- There will be plenty of food, drink and entertainment on offer in the stadium that you can enjoy. Make sure you experience the unique festival atmosphere of Rugby World Cup 2019
- Don't forget your match ticket(s), only valid tickets accepted and readmission is strictly prohibited
- Fans who have purchased unofficial third party tickets face the risk of being denied stadium access
- Due to large crowds, spectators may experience delays when entering the stadium. We recommend you arrive 90 minutes early, allowing at least 60 minutes to clear security and access your seat
- As weather can fluctuate please bring appropriate clothing
- Parking will not be available around match venues so please use public transport
- Bring sufficient cash (Japanese Yen) in case some outlets don't accept card
- Download the official Rugby World Cup 2019 app for the latest information

TRAVEL INFORMATION

- There will be no parking at Sapporo Dome on match days. Please use public transport or taxi services
- Public transport, shuttle buses and taxi services are expected to be very busy before and after the match. Make sure you factor this into your commuting time



The following items are prohibited from being brought into match venues

- Weapons, food and drink, cans, bottles, long umbrellas, large luggage, selfie sticks, drones, flares, radio wave emitting devices (walkie-talkies, wireless microphones, Wi-Fi routers etc)



- Please note that there will be no place to leave luggage either, inside the match venues or outside around the ticket gates
- It is prohibited by law to fly drones in and around Rugby World Cup 2019 venues and Fanzones

- The closest station to Sapporo Dome is Fukuzumi Station on the Subway Toho line. A 13-minute journey from Sapporo Station, Fukuzumi Station is a 10-minute walk to Sapporo Dome
- Free shuttle buses will run between Sapporo Dome around the Fanzones at Odori Park and Sapporo Station South Plaza before and after the match. Shuttle buses to the station start 3.75 hours before kick-off and until 1 hour and 15 minutes before kick-off. Please allow at least 45 minutes for the journey
- Free shuttle buses will also run before and after the match between Sapporo Dome and four stations, Makomanai Station and Hiragishi Station on the Subway Namboku Line, Nango Juhatchome Chome Station on the Tozai Line and JR Shiroishi Station. Please allow between 15 and 30 minutes for the shuttle bus journey
- Please also allow plenty of time to get your transport back and do not leave it until the last service

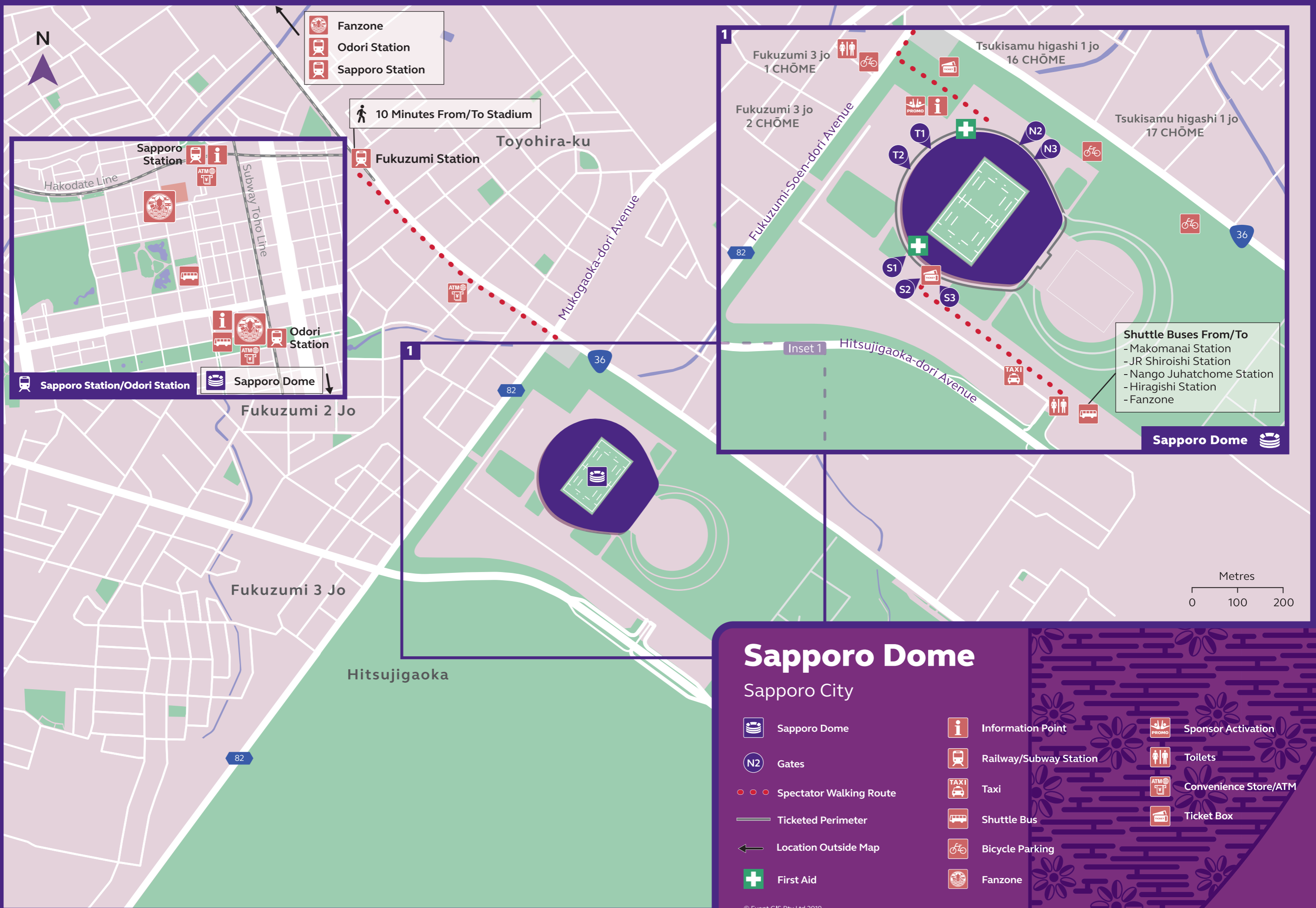

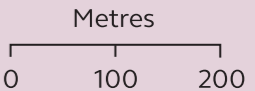
