- Mountains and nature are only a short distance from Tokyo, with the top of Mt Takao offering stunning views of the majestic Mount Fuji.

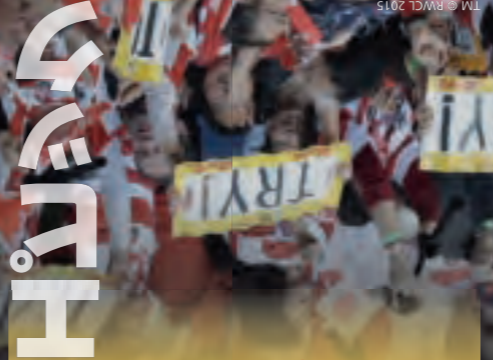
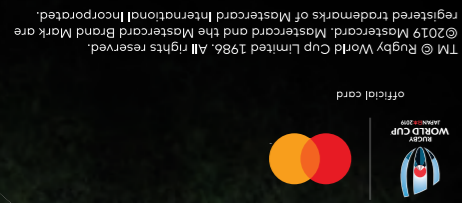

GETTING TO THE FANZONE

Tokyo will host two Fanzones

- Chofu Station Square**
 - Located in front of Chofu Station, Keio line
 - Stadium access via direct bus link
- Fanzone opening days
 - 20, 21, 22, 23, 28, 29 September
 - 4, 5, 6, 12, 13, 19, 20, 26, 27 October
 - 1, 2 November

Please note that the Fanzone will focus on public viewings on 23 September and 4, 11 October.
- Tokyo Sports Square**
 - 1-minute walk from JR / Tokyo Metro Yurakucho Station, Ginza Station, Ginza Ichome Station, Hibiya Station
- Fanzone opening days
 - All 26 match days
 - Official Rugby World Cup 2019 Merchandise will be sold during and between match days

- There will be plenty of food, drink and entertainment on offer in the stadium that you can enjoy. Make sure you experience the unique festival atmosphere of Rugby World Cup 2019
- Don't forget your match ticket(s), only valid tickets accepted and readmission is strictly prohibited
- Fans who have purchased unofficial third party tickets face the risk of being denied stadium access
- Due to large crowds, spectators may experience delays when entering the stadium. We recommend you arrive 90 minutes early, allowing at least 60 minutes to clear security and access your seat

- As weather can fluctuate please bring appropriate clothing
- Parking will not be available around match venues so please use public transport
- Bring sufficient cash (Japanese Yen) in case some outlets don't accept card
- Download the official Rugby World Cup 2019 app for the latest information
- Tokyo Stadium will include a specially designed Spectator Plaza with a variety of entertainment, including Heineken bars, dining outlets and Rugby World Cup 2019 activities. Arrive early and soak up the atmosphere of the area before making your way to the seating bowl

The following items are prohibited from being brought into match venues

- Weapons, food and drink, cans, bottles, long umbrellas, large luggage, selfie sticks, drones, flares, radio wave emitting devices (walkie-talkies, wireless microphones, Wi-Fi routers etc)
- Image icons showing prohibited items: weapons, food/drink, cans/bottles, long umbrellas, large luggage, selfie sticks, drones, flares, walkie-talkies, wireless microphones, Wi-Fi routers.
- Please note that there will be no place to leave luggage either, inside the match venues or outside around the ticket gates
- It is prohibited by law to fly drones in and around Rugby World Cup 2019 venues and Fanzones

TRAVEL INFORMATION

- Check the map for your journey, listen to announcements and follow directions from staff
- It is expected to be very busy after the match, particularly at Tobitakyu Station. Please be prepared to queue, we will get you on your way as quickly as possible
- If you are travelling back by train, please consider taking the 10-minute walk to Tobitakyu Station for the Keio Line, or the 30-minute walk to Tama Station for the Seibu Tamagawa Line. Alternatively, Keio Nishi-Chōfu Station is a 15-minute walk from the stadium. Shuttle buses also go to Tama, Mushashi-Sakai, Mushashi-Koganei (after the match only), Komae and Chofu Stations so please check their pick-up points on the map
- If you have some spare time after the match, please stop by the Spectator Plaza and enjoy the atmosphere before heading back
- Allow plenty of time to get your transport back and do not leave it until the last service

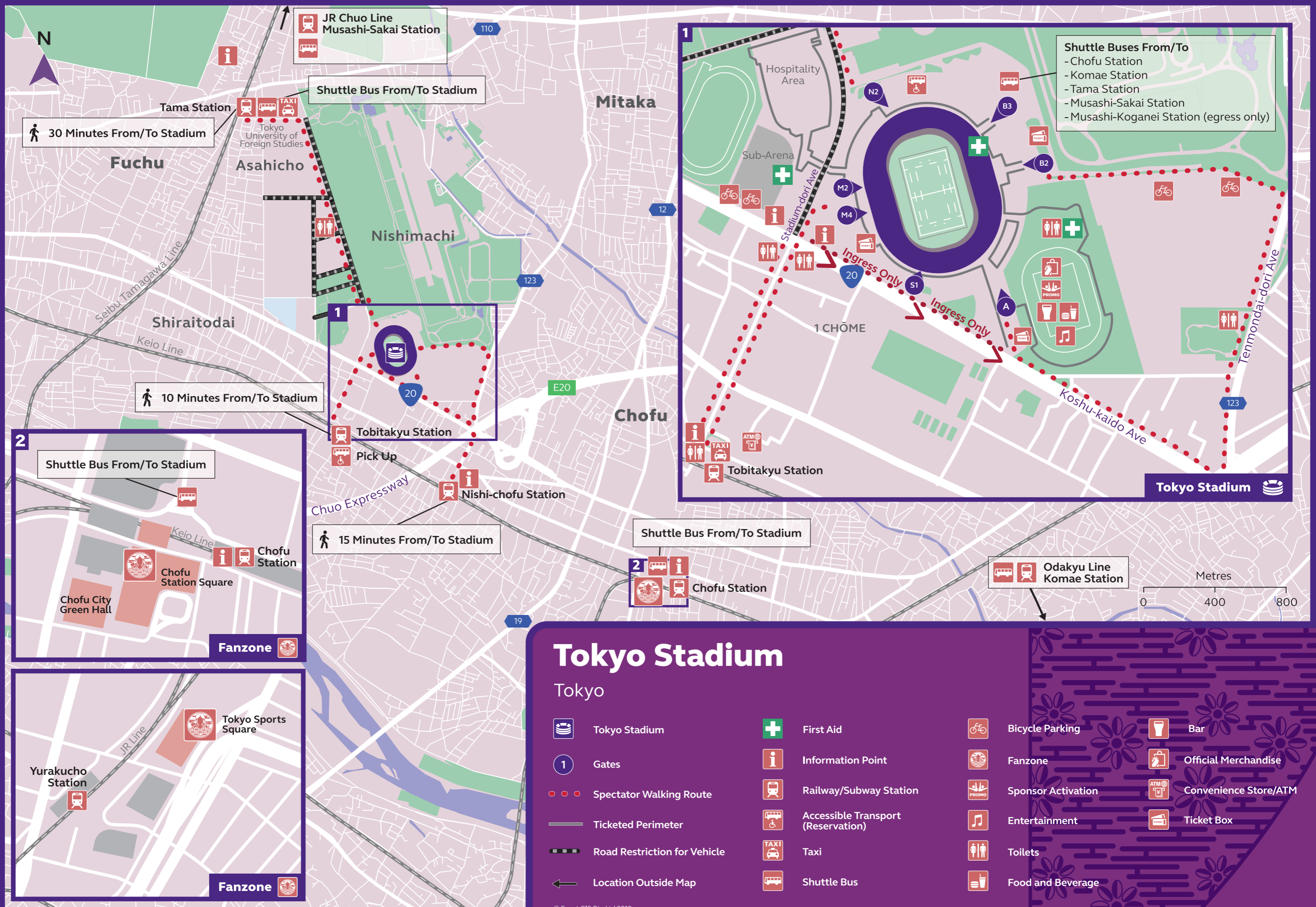
